CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

Thursday, November 14, 2024

1. **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Pro Tem Lewis called the City Council meeting for November 14, 2024 to order at 06:00 PM.

4. **COUNCIL DISCUSSION ITEMS**

- A. Presentation on Muscatine Aquatic Center Update Plan
Staff provided a presentation with information related to the update plan for the Muscatine Aquatic Center. The presentation included background on the Aquatic Center, 2024 season accomplishments, and items for consideration for updates or replacement within the Aquatic Center including pool lights, replacement benches and tables, shade umbrellas, and more.
- B. Presentation on Muscatine Boat Harbor and Marina Update Plan
Staff provided a presentation with information related to the update plan for the Muscatine Boat Harbor and Marina. The presentation included background on the Boat Harbor, marina measurement details, 2024 season statistics, and items for consideration for updates or replacement in the Boat Harbor including boat lifts, covered slips, dredging, and more.

- D. Proposed Installation of Public Art on MuscaBus Shelters
Staff provided a presentation with information regarding the installation of

Public Art on the Muscabus Shelters. The presentation included estimated costs and funding options, involvement of the Public Art Advisory Commission and City Council on decisions about what is placed on shelters.

There was a consensus from City Council to move forward with the pilot project of placing art on the Shelter located at City Hall.

E. Project Update from Engineering Division of Public Works

Staff provided a presentation with information related to the ongoing and upcoming Public Works projects to include: West Hill Sewer Separation phases 6A, 6B, 6C and 6D, Fulliam Reconstruction Project, Redundant Force Main, Devitt Avenue Sidewalks, Isett Corridor Reconstruction, Dick Drake Railroad Overpass and Park Avenue West Bridge Replacement.

F. Discussion of Proposed Traffic Control at Leroy and Bidwell Intersection

Staff provided a presentation regarding the intersection of Bidwell and Leroy Street. Staff shared information regarding the history of the traffic flow at this intersection and reasoning for wanting to make the proposed changes. Several traffic configurations were discussed with City Council agreeing to move forward with Stop signs in both directions on Bidwell at Leroy Street. Staff will bring an item back to Council for final Approval.
