

City of Muscatine, Council Minutes, January 13, 2026 – City Hall

Mayor Bark called the City Council meeting for January 13, 2026, to order at 05:30 PM.

Councilmembers Present: Brockert, Jindrich, Osborne, Gordon, Lewis, Lampe, Conard.

Discussion Items:

Brian Stineman-Public Works Director, Kevin Coon-City Engineer, Candace Bark-Stanley Consultants gave a presentation on options for the Papoose Sewer Pump Station project. Ms. Bark explained the options of renovating the existing pump station as well as the option of building a new pump station in a non-flood zone. She stated the City staff along with Stanley agreed that the best option would be to build a new facility along with adding an option for a stormwater portable pump site for use during flood situations. There was a consensus with City Council to move forward with the design process and funding options for this project.

Presentation by Chris Jasper - Emergency Management Director for Muscatine County on the County Wide Emergency Plan. Mr. Jasper shared the different aspects of the plan, how it would incorporate the entire county in the event of a mass emergency and the roles individuals would take in the event. Mr. Jasper encouraged the City of Muscatine to adopt the County plan as the City plan as all of the other towns within the county have already done in order to get the entire county on the same page regarding emergency management. There was a consensus with City Council to move forward with the adoption of the County plan.
